PROF. DAVID G. HENRY, SR. Registered Patent Attorney and Patent Law Professor

I'd like to introduce **Professor David G. Henry**. In addition to teaching at Baylor Law School and in the Hankamer School of Business, Prof. Henry is a Law Firm Partner, doing **patent and trademark litigation** throughout the United States and internationally (usually traveling **AS PILOT**, flying himself to his meetings and court matters).
